Christian Tutors of America (CTA) is a ministry, <u>not</u> a business. As a nonprofit organization, our goal is to provide superior academic assistance at the fairest rates possible. Furthermore, our tutors are not only well-qualified and experienced, they are strong Christian believers who use their gifts and talents to bless God and serve others.

CTA is a partner with <u>Step Up for Students</u> (Florida only). Families on the Step Up Program are eligible to be reimbursed for services by submitting invoices to Step Up for Students.

In Addition,

We are pleased to announce that starting in the Fall of 2024, CTA will be offering a limited amount of financial aid and scholarships to those genuinely in (financial) need and who can benefit from our ministry.

Those who qualify must meet the following criteria:

Students must:

- Want to come to tutoring or homeschool
- Make a full effort at all times
- Demonstrate continued progress
- Maintain a positive attitude
- Not have major or ongoing discipline problems at home or at school

Students may be asked to complete community service as a condition of financial aid.

Parents:

- Must be experiencing a financial situation that would prevent them from paying full or partial tuition.
- Must respect the CTA vision and Philosophy of Christian Education

Parents may be asked to assist in some aspect of our ministry.

Financial Aid/Scholarship blocks for <u>tutoring</u> (not homeschool) are set for 5-week intervals (10 sessions), after which families may reapply for another block. There is no limit to the number of times a family can apply.

At or near the end of a student's tutoring block, an evaluation of progress will be conducted by the CTA director. Parents may be asked to participate in the meeting.

Homeschool financial aid or scholarships are for the academic year.
